Not the First Time for IFCA

 IFCA conducted minibulk collections from 2002 – 2009;

Have collected over 8,000 tanks

 Took 2010 off due to confusion over pending PCC regulations

Education Efforts on PCC

USEPA presented at IFCA convention in 2009

IDA presented at IFCA convention in 2010
 and 2011

- IFCA invited to many dealer meetings
- Preparing No Nonsense Compliance Brochure

Feedback from Retailers

 Concerned about farmers breaking seals; expect very little cooperation from farmers

 Concerned about the cost of cleaning tanks (estimated \$25 per tank) taking into account employee costs and rinsate management costs

Feedback from Retailers



- Those with heavy "to the farm" business looking at nonrefillables as being most cost effective
- No serious plans we can see for recycling other than IFCA program

Feedback from Retailers

 Not sure how to manage this during the peak busy season

 Some relief seen if they understand and segregate "service containers"

Some distributors assessing fee if seal gets broken. Who pays it?

Reality

 Don't believe farmers will recycle tanks

See an opportunity for low service providers

 Hope to not see old containers where they don't belong.
