Keys to Success

- These programs will not be successful without the support of the manufacturers
- Dealers Inventory survey forms are collected, verified and sent to the manufacturer prior to recycling
- 3rd party validation of the container required
- Every container registered into the program @\$15 per unit which is paid by the dealer
- Teaming with IBC-NA on the cage totes
- Eliminate the liability of the container on-site
- Education is still key to eliminate reuse of containers that are to be recycled



TIME LINE OF THE PROGRAM

- Inventory form must be submitted by July 15th
- Scheduled to start in Minnesota July 25th
- Expect to conclude by October 31st
- Manufactures can expect ongoing communication from either the States Department of Ag, Agribusiness Assn or TRI Rinse, Inc.
- This program takes significant coordination from several organizations to be successful
